Recommendations by the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices

When a COVID-19 vaccine is authorized by FDA and recommended by ACIP, vaccination in the initial phase of the COVID-19 vaccination program (Phase 1a) should be offered to both:

1. health care personnel, and
2. residents of long-term care facilities.

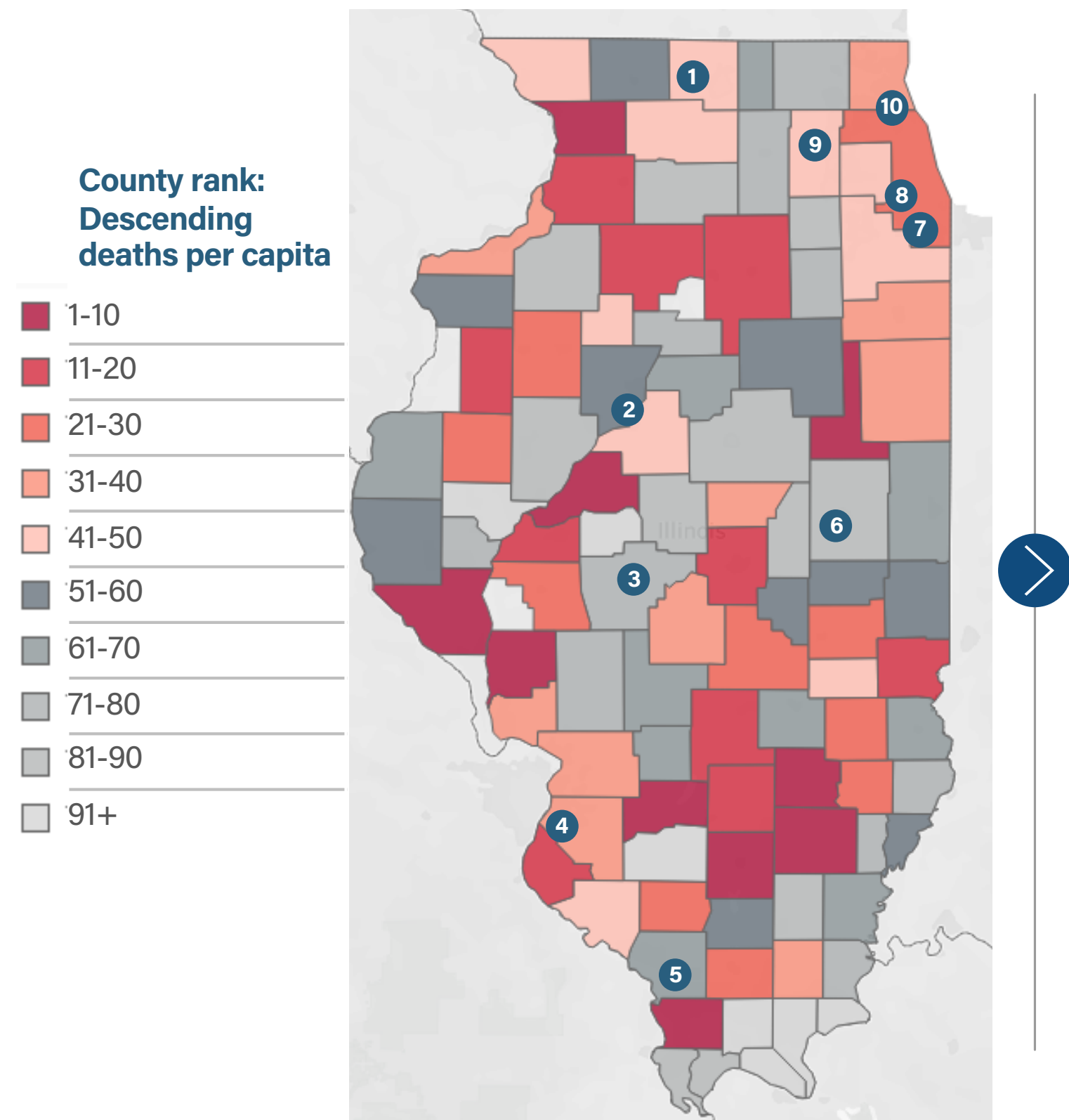

Phase 1A in Illinois: Geographic Prioritization

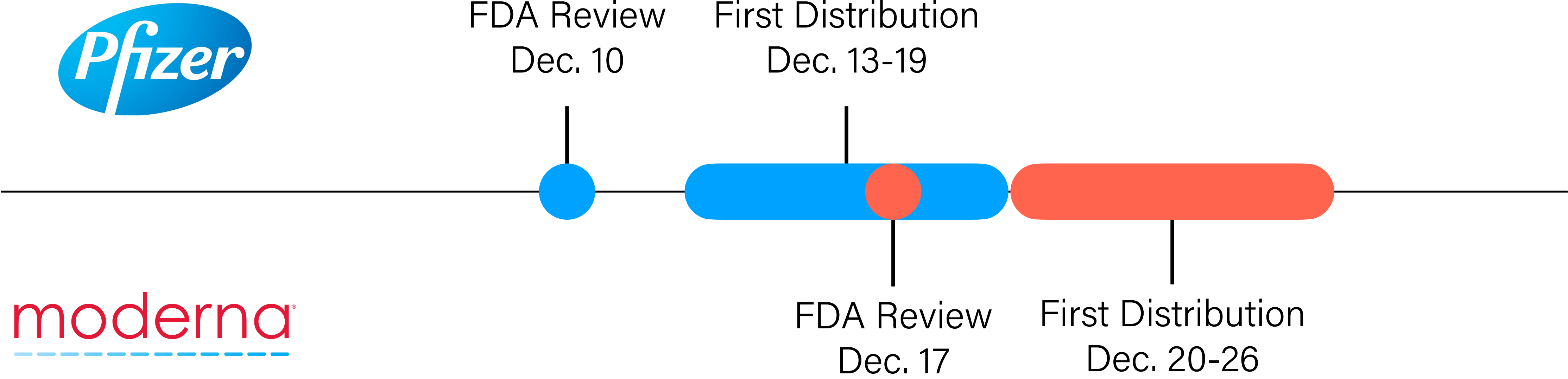
The first vaccines will be directed to the 50 counties with the highest death rates per capita via 10 Regional Hospital Coordinating Centers.
