**Philips Respironics** is voluntarily recalling the below devices due to two (2) issues related to the polyester-based polyurethane (PE-PUR) sound abatement foam used in Philips Continuous and Non-Continuous Ventilators. The PR-PUR foam may degrade into particles which may enter the device’s air pathway and be ingested or inhaled by the user and the PE-PUR foam may off-gas certain chemicals. The foam degradation may also be exacerbated by use of unapproved cleaning methods. These issues can result in serious injury which can be life threatening, cause permanent impairment, and/or require medical intervention to preclude permanent impairment.
